The temporary exhaust fan located in #3 entry is currently off, but can be started if needed, by utilizing the switch located in the fresh air base. However once started it cannot be turned off. The underground power has been locked out and is currently guarded. There is a trained mine rescue team onsite to serve as your back-up. Your team's assignment is to explore to the faces. There is a lifeline man here to handle your lifeline. The mine maps are up to date except for anything mined last night. This is all the information available except for Additional instructions that will be given to you with the maps.

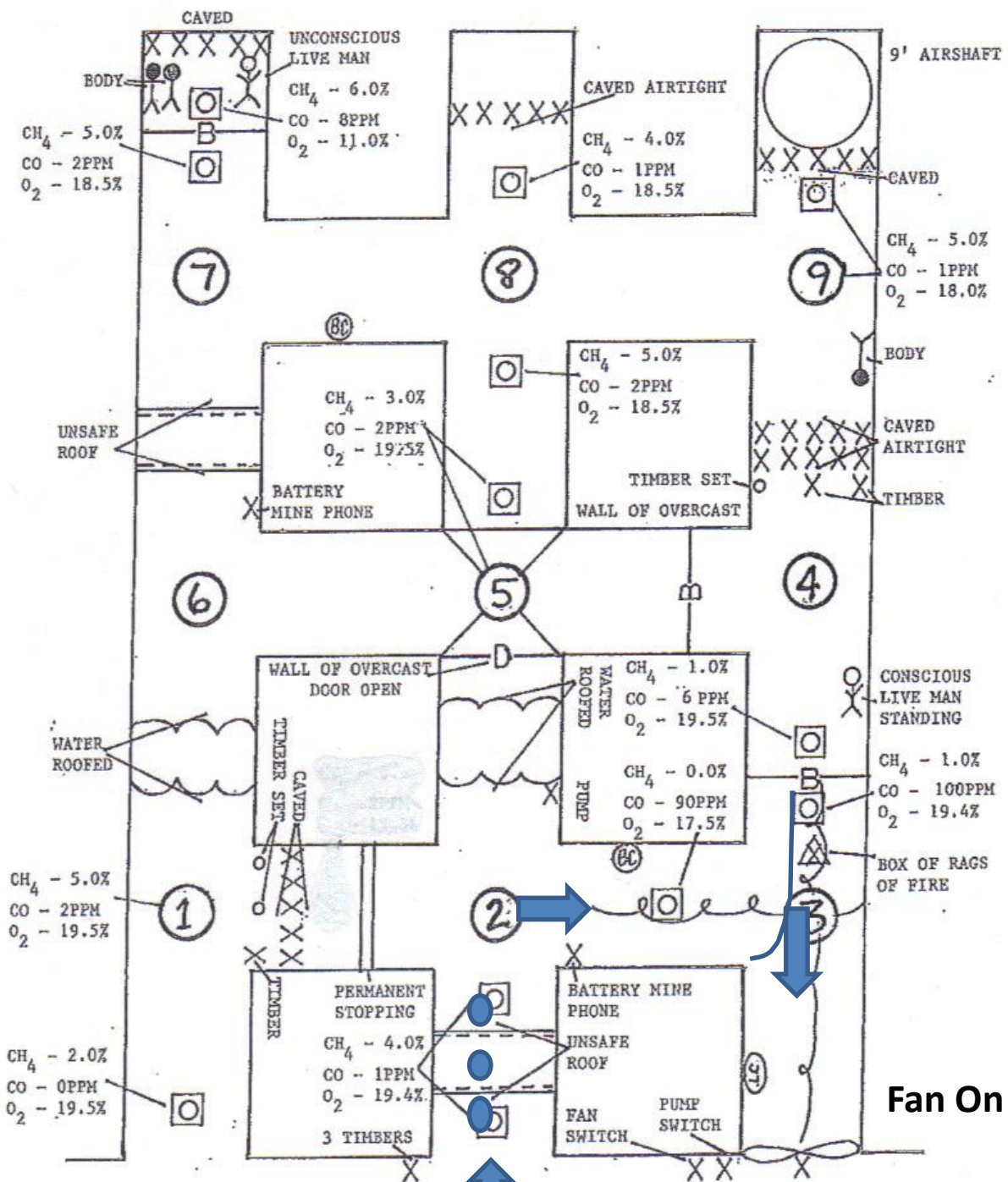

4. ONCE STARTED THE FAN CANNOT BE TURNED OFF OR REVERSED.

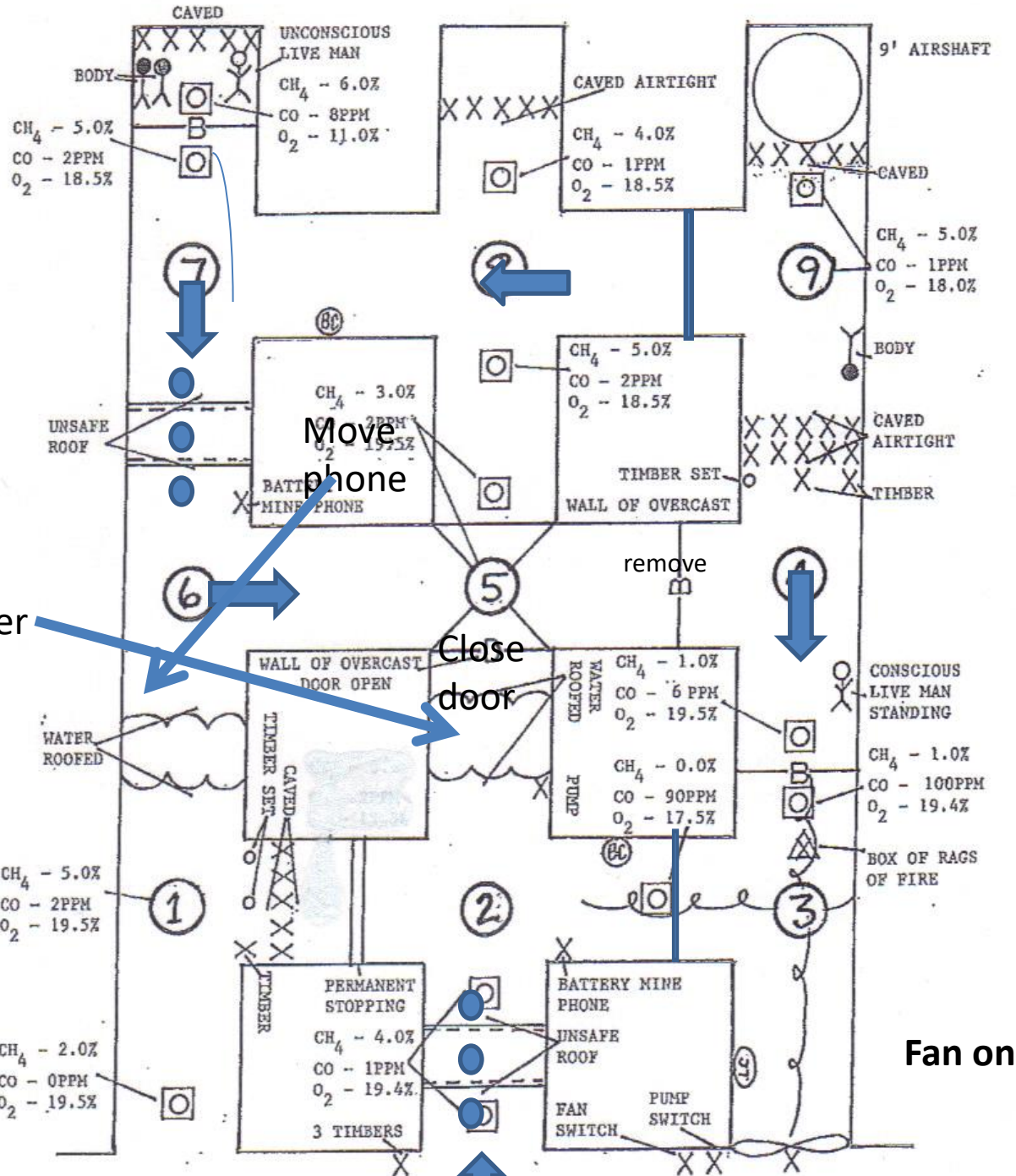

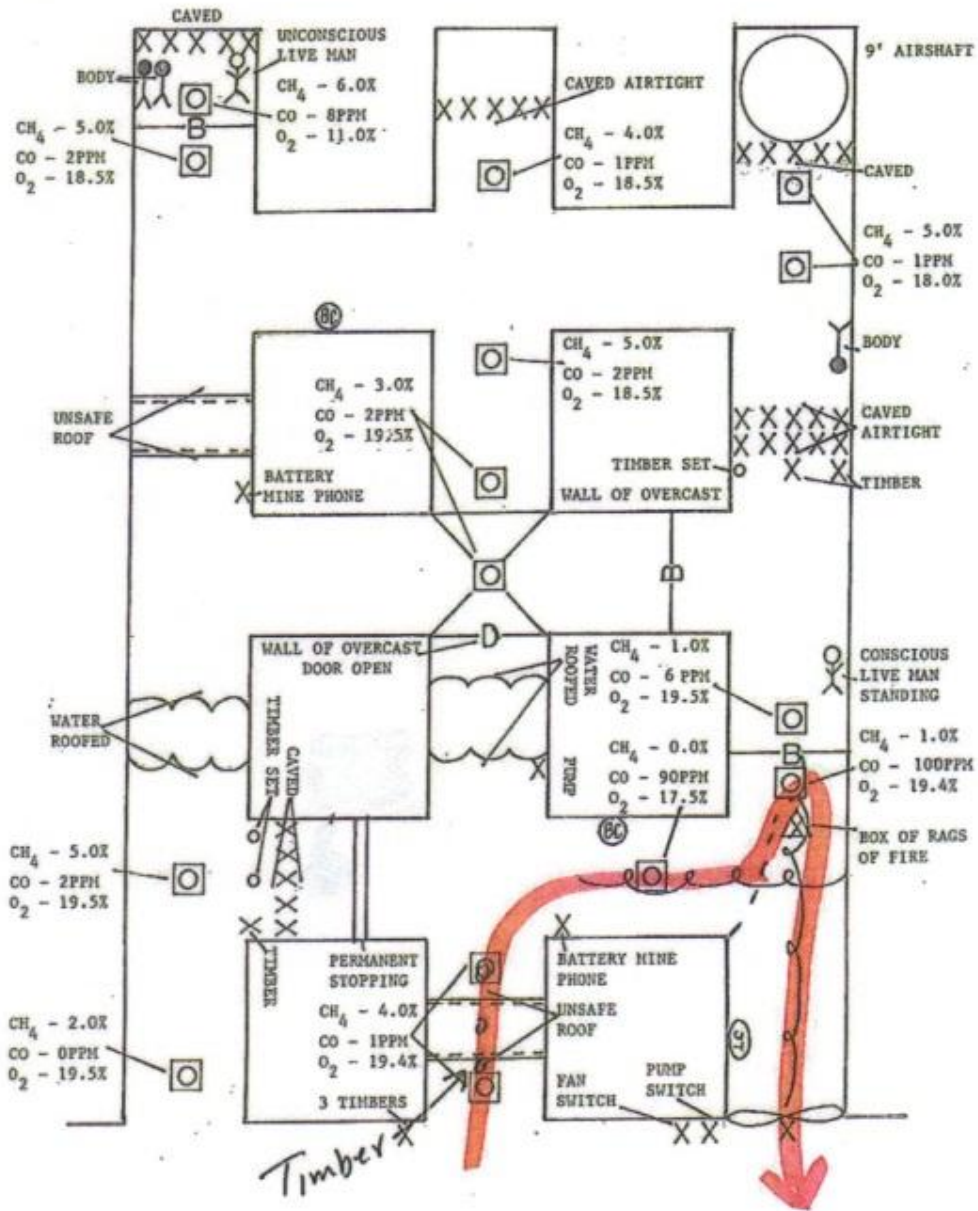
