

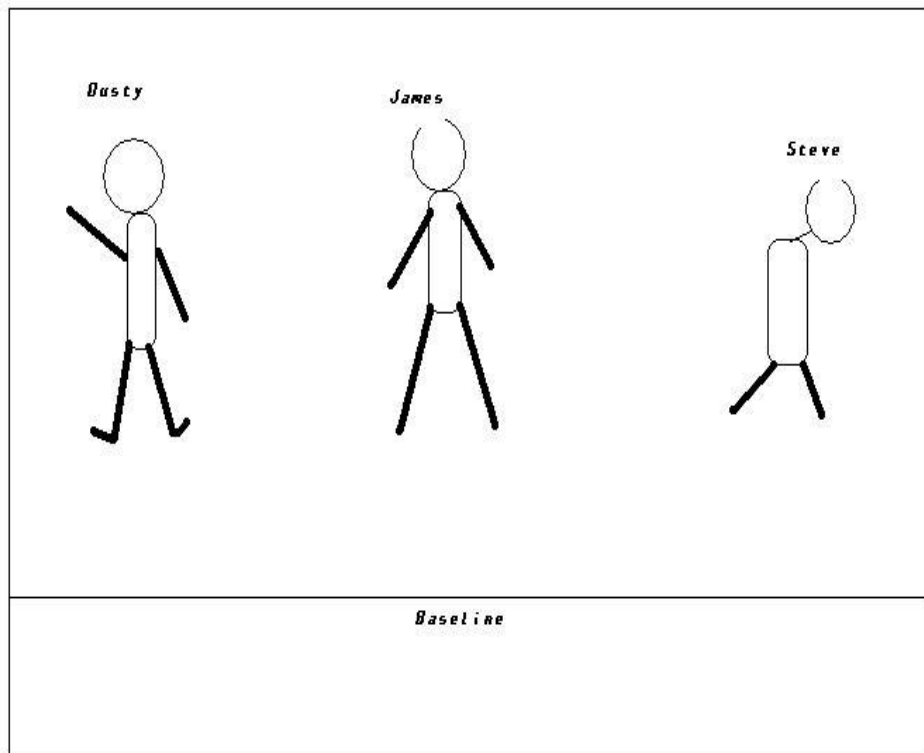
First Aid Problem #2

Statement for Teams

Thanks for responding so quickly. Elvis was driving the right shuttle car. Steve, Dusty, and James were building a brattice across from Elvis' dump. The block curtain was still hung and Elvis forgot they were building a brattice. James was capping off the brattice when Elvis came through the curtain and hit him, pushing him through the brattice into Steve and Dusty. Dusty escapes with minor injuries, James was not so fortunate. He is conscious; his respirations are about 35 per minute caused by a life threatening condition, Flail chest, on his left side. He has life threatening bleeding on his neck. His left leg appears to have been cut off at the knee and has life threatening bleeding from it. We suspect spinal injury. James and the blocks landed on top of Steve, it appears his neck is broken and is not breathing. He has told the unit that he has a DNR (Do Not Resuscitate) Order. He also wears the medical alert bracelet. Thank you and good luck.

Field Layout

You could use Annie as Steve and turn her head around to the back side. You also will have to put the DNR on her wrist. Dusty can also be used as a bystander; he should be standing when the problem starts. If you use Dusty I would ask him to put on BSI's. The field layout is below.



Judges Statement

This is an immediate condition for James. Dusty has minor injuries that do not require treatment or assessment; he may be used as a bystander. Steve is dead. The bleeding is controlled before the fail chest condition. Only the life threats are treated. The wounds are listed below.
