

While traveling from the mine, you and your partner receive a call from #3 unit where three miners were, working on overcast for the new section. 1 of miners has called out that while using an acetylene torch to cut the overcast rails an ignition occurred.

Upon arrival, you find the one miner at the telephone. While visibly shaken by the accident he is uninjured. You travel on to the work area where you find one of the miners laying lifeless on the mine floor with no pulse and is not breathing.

The third miner is laying on the mine floor with first, second, and third degree burns on the upper body, minor cuts and abrasions, and a broken Tibia at the left ankle where the rail struck his leg.

The area is now safe to work, and transportation to the surface is immediately available. EMS has been notified, and are waiting on the surface.

The problem will end when you have treated all injuries, readied the victim for transport to the surface and the clock is stopped.
