# Mine Rescue Statement 2015 B

- Welcome to The New View # 2 mine. This mine has a history of bad top and water, and the mine is a gassy mine. This morning about 3:00 am, an examiner encountered smoke inby the # 3 entry in our main west panel. He notified management and retreated to the surface. All workers have been evacuated and accounted for except for 4 people. We have had no contact with these people since the smoke was encountered. We have a split shaft with an exhaust fan. There is a man hoist on the intake side of the shaft. The fan is off and guarded at the present time. The fan may be started when needed, but once started the fan cannot be shut off, reversed or stalled. The fresh air base is located on the surface, and the map is up to date. All agencies have been notified and a backup mine rescue team is on the property. The shaft is being monitored.
  - This is all the information I have for you at this time.

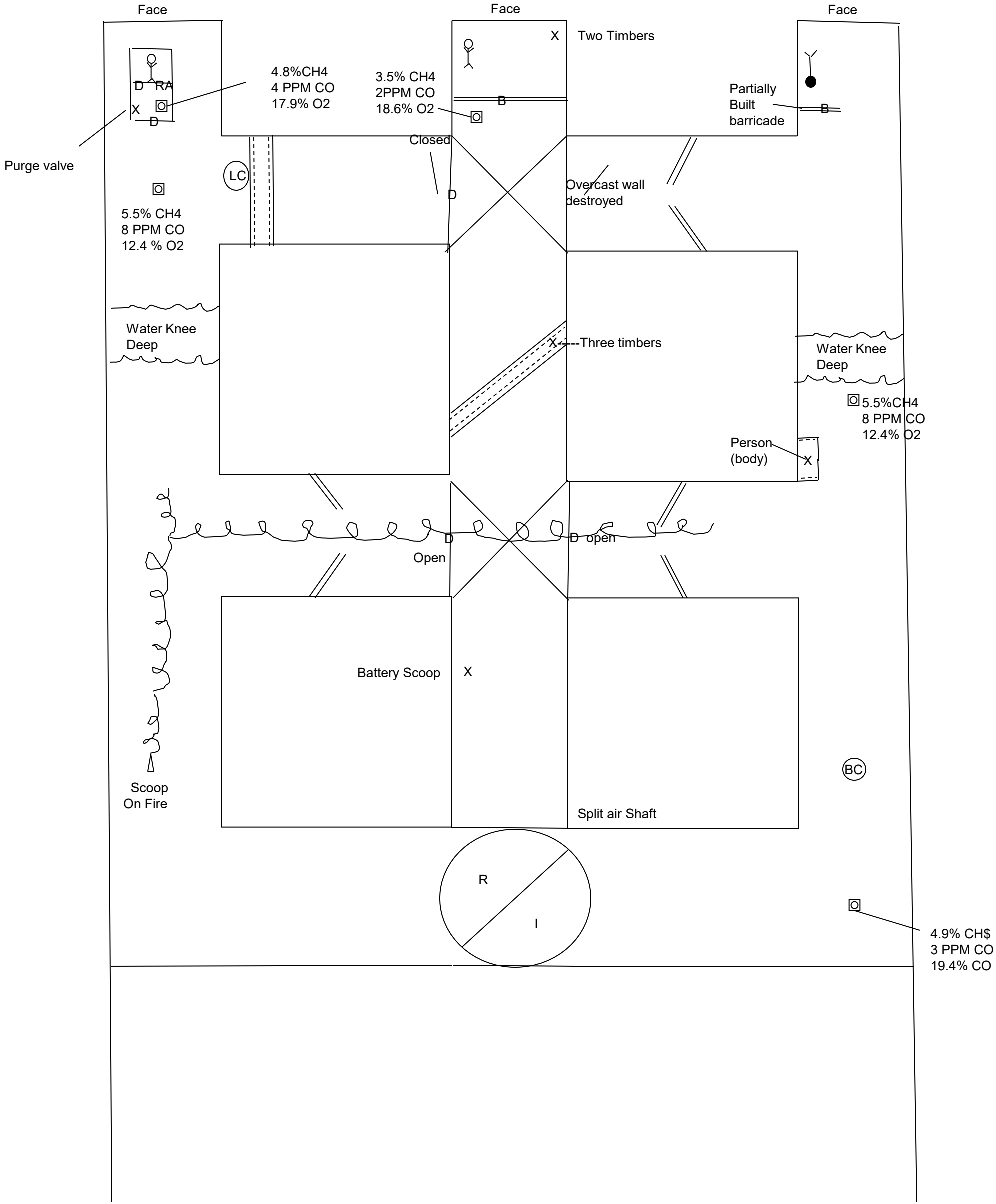
# Mine Rescue Problem

- 2015 B Skills Problem

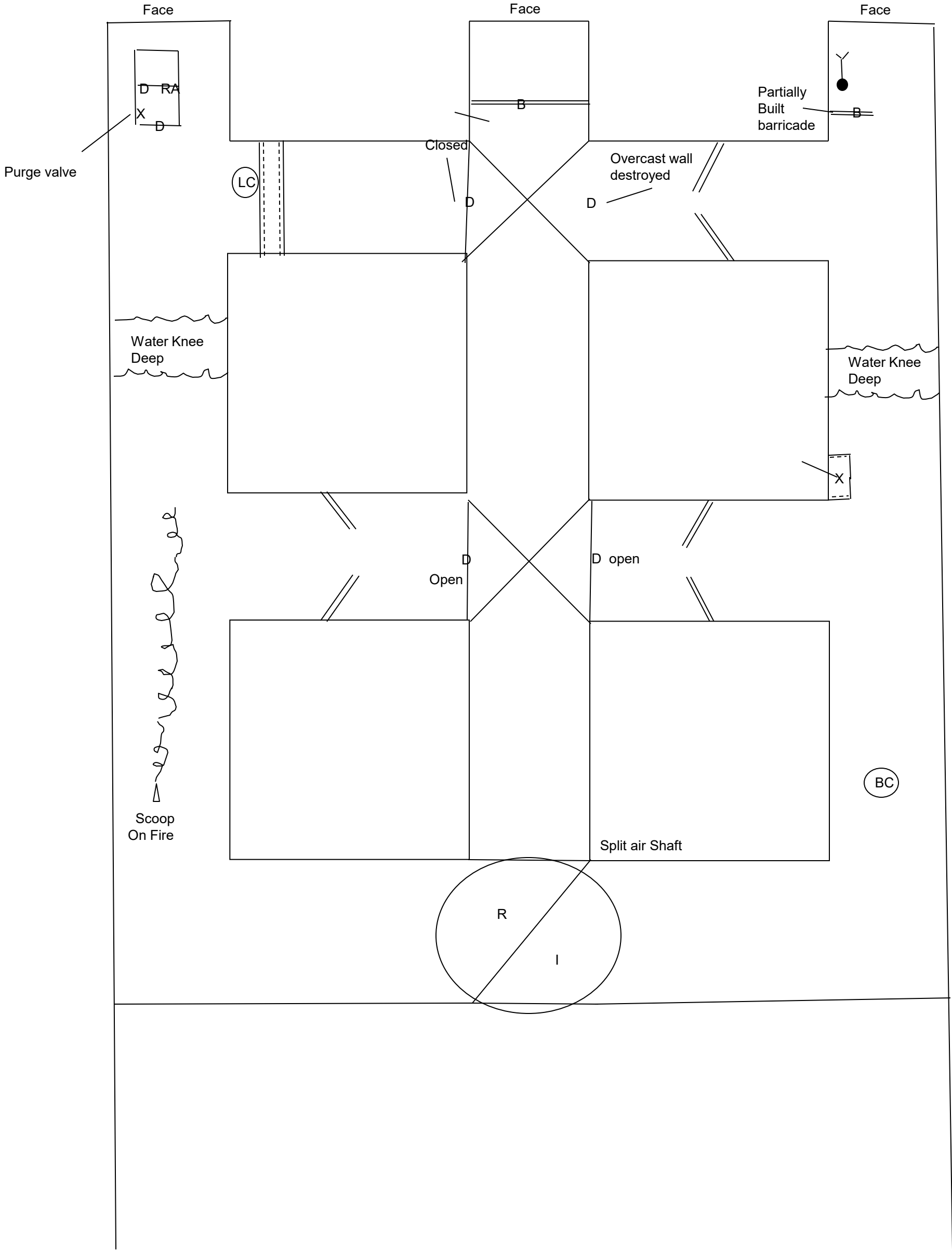

There will a 60 minute time limit

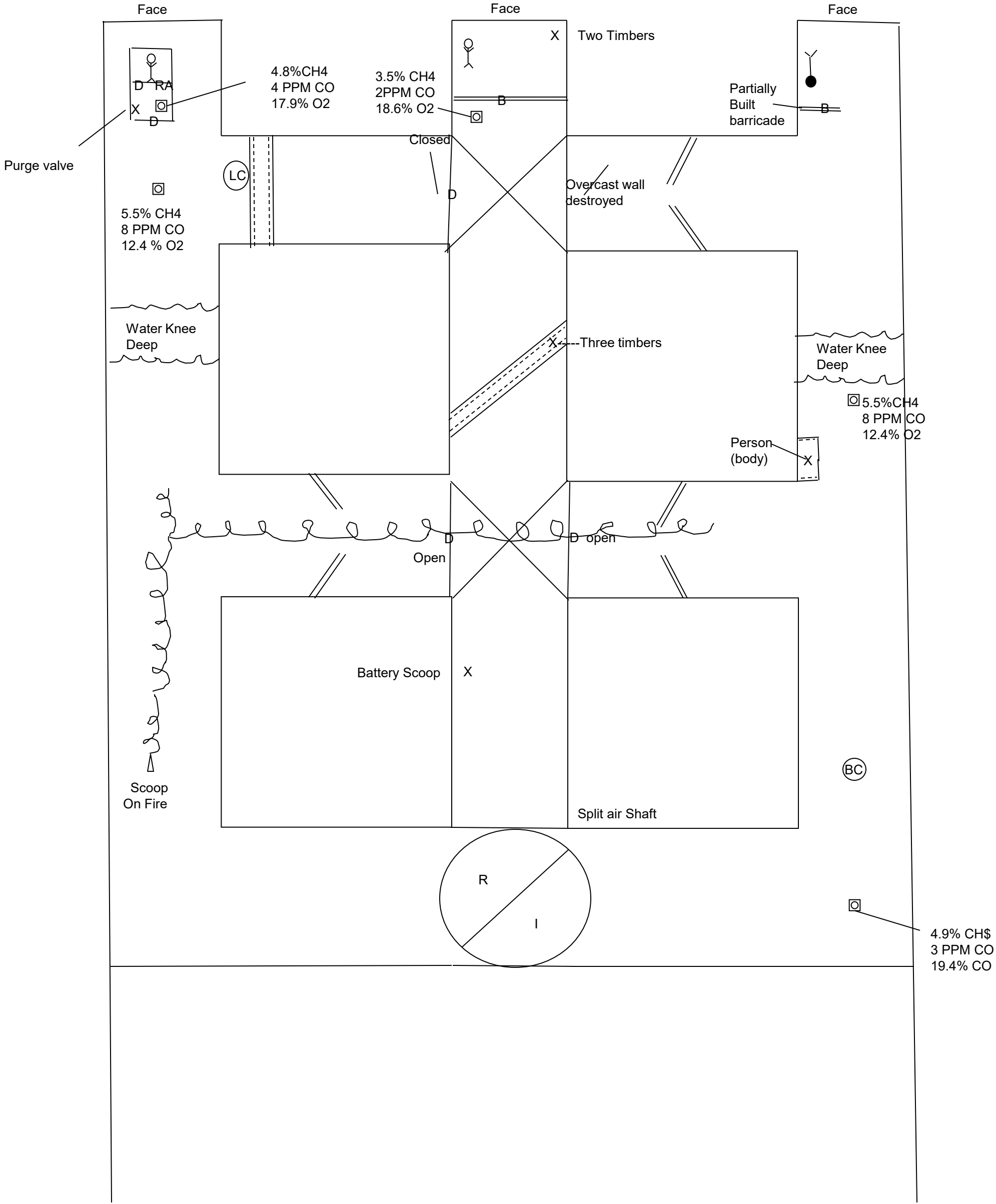

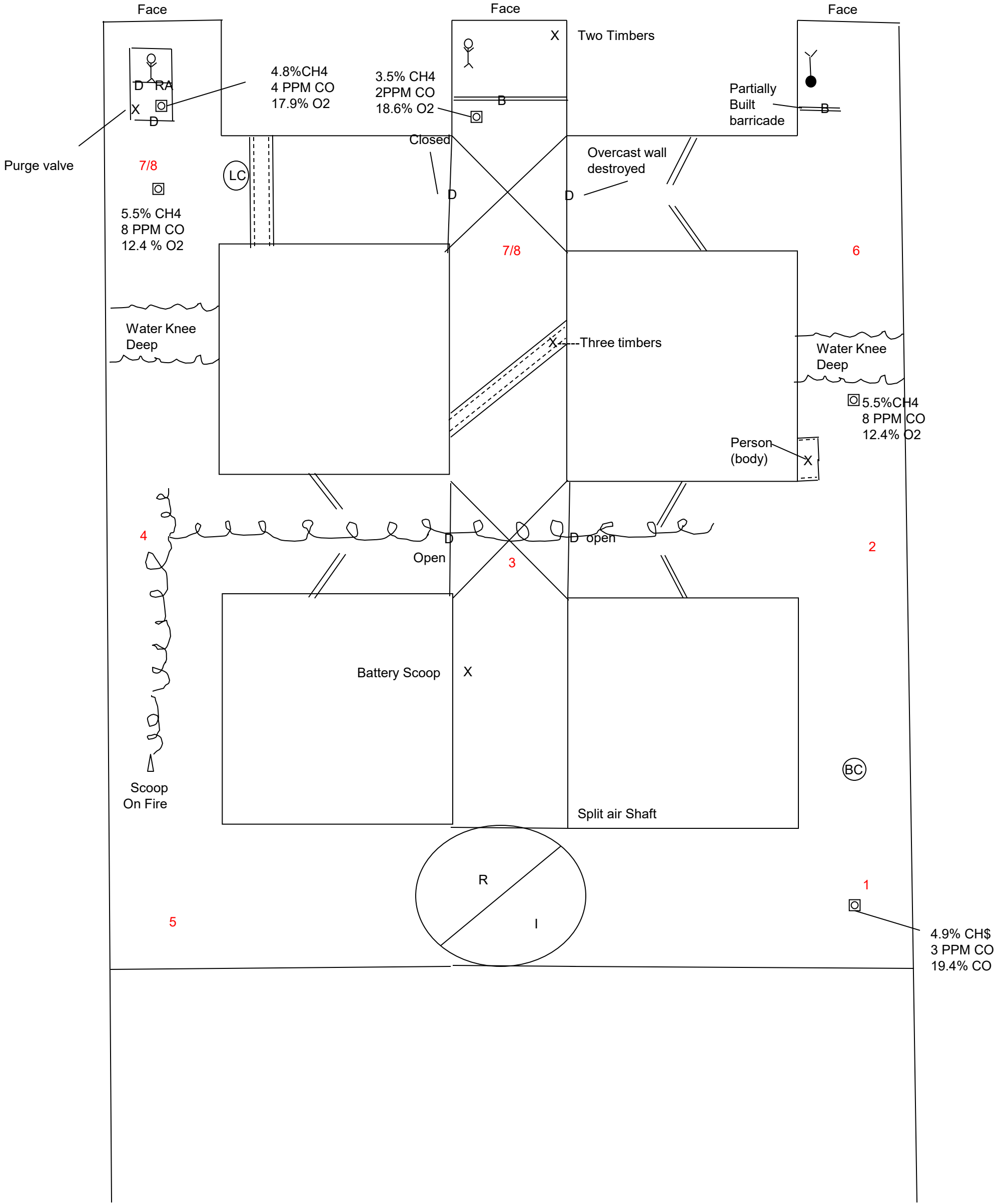

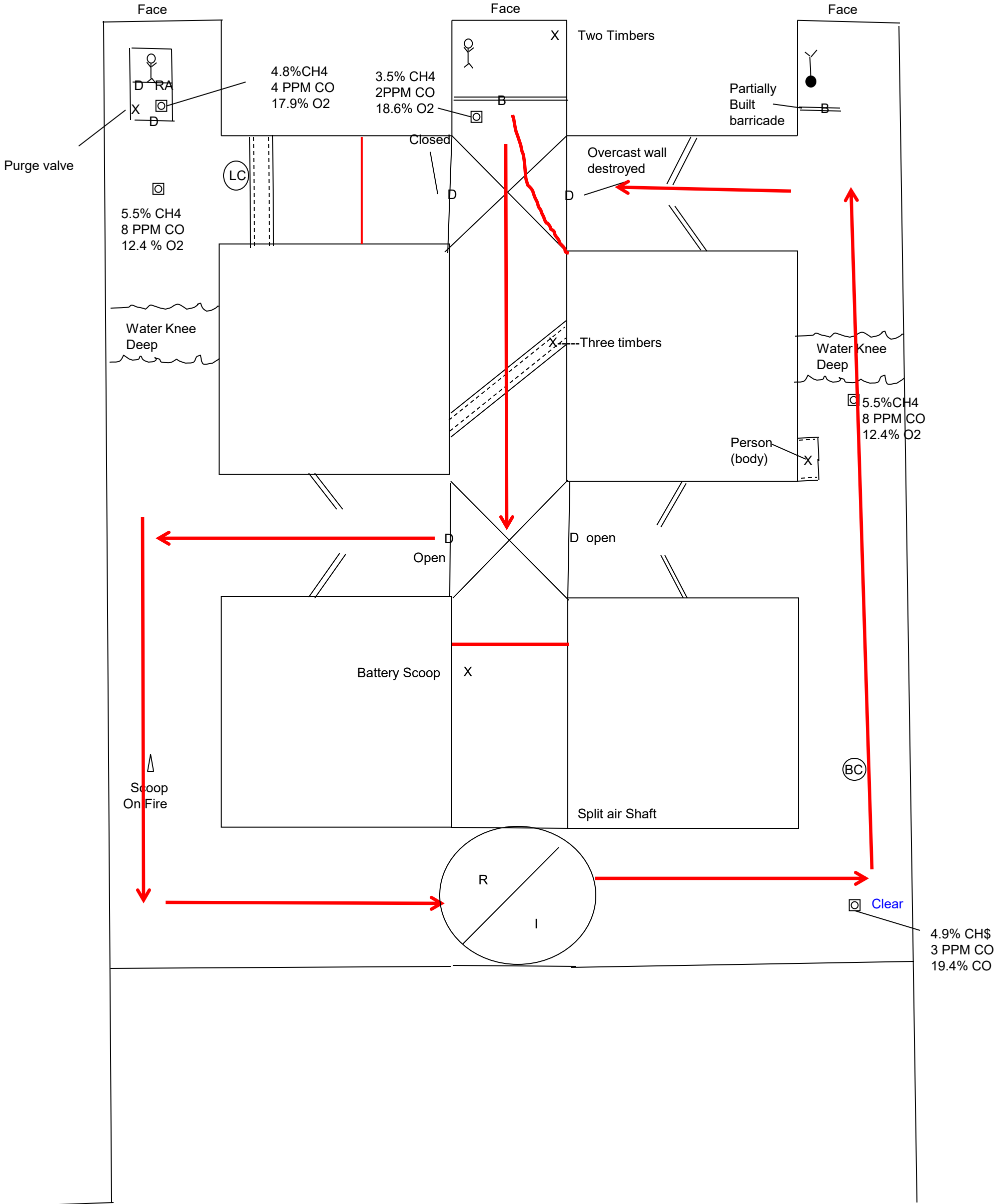

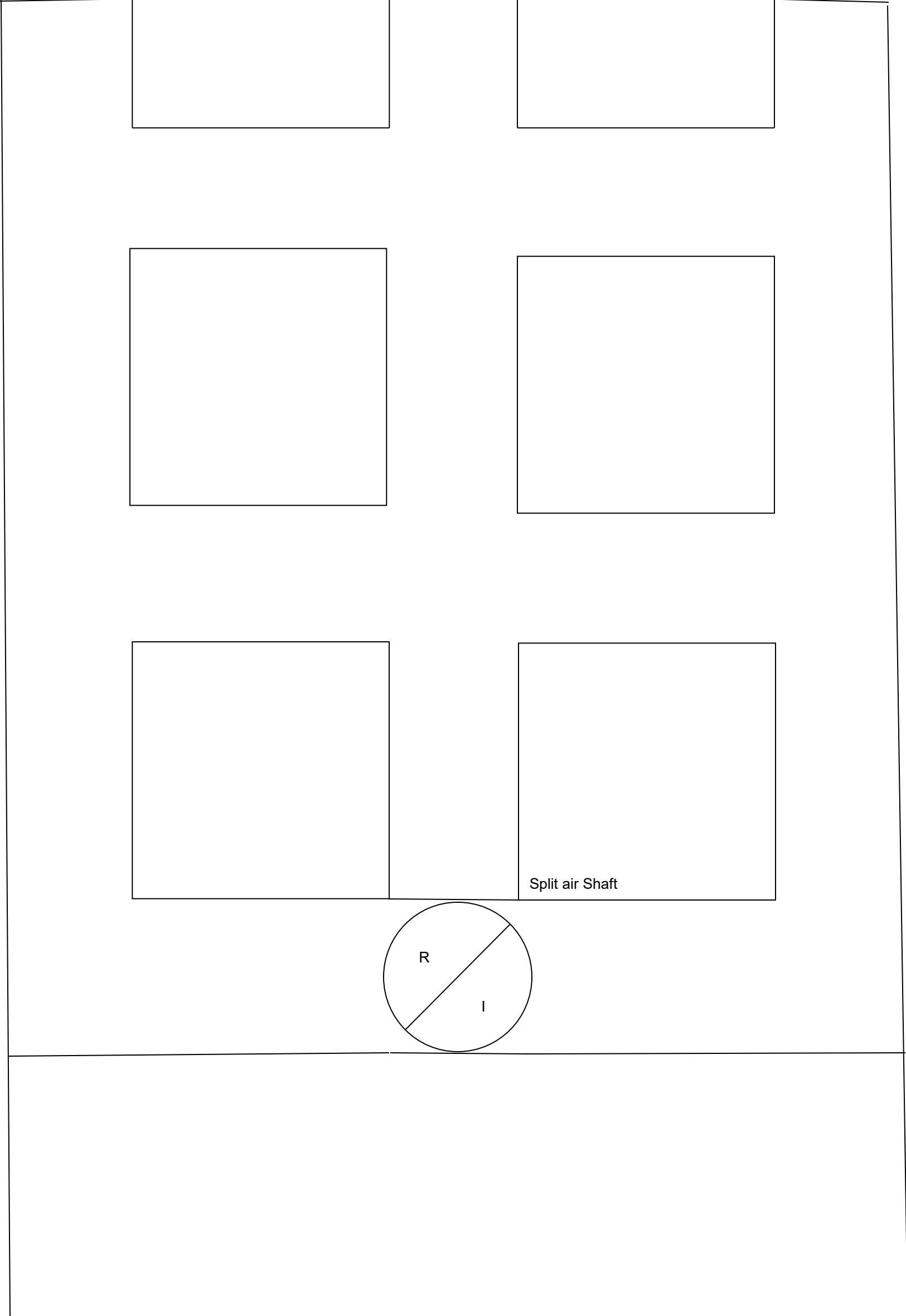
