JUDGING GUIDANCE

JIM IS AN IMMEDIATE PATIENT. TEAM SHOULD PERFORM RAPID ASSESSMENT, IDENTIFYING ALL INJURIES AND THEN TRANSPORT. Team should pick up backboard and state transporting patient. (Rule 15)

AFTER TRANSPORTING JIM THE TEAM WILL PERFORM A COMPLETE ASSESSMENT OF JOE AND TREAT ALL INJURIES AND CONDITIONS AS ENCOUNTERED.

IF THEY DO NOT COVER BOTH EYES, PAD AROUND THE IMPALED OBJECT, OR PLACE GAUZE BETWEEN THE BURNED FINGERS DISCOUNT UNDER RULE 10 FOR IMPROPERLY HANDLING PATIENT BECAUSE FAILURE TO DO THESE WOULD COMPROMISE PATIENT CONDITION AND MAKE INJURIES WORSE.

PROCEDURES 4 AND 5 OF THE BURN SKILL SHEET DO NOT APPLY AS THIS IS THERMAL BURNS. DO NOT DISCOUNT TEAM IF THEY DO OR DO NOT VERBALIZE THIS PORTIONS OF THE SKILL SHEETS.

THE SKILL SHEETS FOR BANDAGING OF OPEN WOUNDS DO NOT APPLY FOR THE TREATMENT OF THE BURNS BUT ARE INCLUDED AS A REFERENCE FOR THE BANDAGING OF THE BURNS. DO NOT DISCOUNT THE TEAMS BASED ON THESE SKILL SHEETS BUT DO DISCOUNT UNDER RULE 10. (BRADY TEXT PAGES 380, 385 AND 387).

IF TEAM FAILS TO CHANGE GLOVES BETWEEN PATIENTS DOCK UNDER RULE 20. (THIS WOULD ONLY APPLY IF TEAM MEMBER ACTUALLY CONTACTS THE PATIENT AFTER TOUCHING THE OTHER PATIENT).
